Purpose of report

The appointment of the Chief Executive of the PCC is a senior appointment that has to be reviewed by the panel. Although the panel cannot veto the appointment it can make recommendations with regard to it. When the current Chief Executive was appointed as a secondment from Hertfordshire County Council the PCC advised the panel that the appointment was to be for a trial period of 12 months. The panel approved the appointment in March 2013. The panel was later advised that this secondment would be extended by 6 months because of changes of staff and office meaning the PCC had not had the time to consider the post with a settled office. The panel agreed to that extension. The PCC now presents the report attached with his proposals for the panel to consider.
